



KLANE.V. - Info :

Classification of Koi

1. Kohaku	all Kohaku (white koi, red colour), except Tancho (only red on the head) and Kanoko (red dotted scales) – no Ginrin, no Doitsu.
2. Taisho-Sanke	all Sanke (white koi, black and red colour), except Tancho (only red on the head) – no Ginrin, no Doitsu.
3. Showa-Sanshoku	all Showa (black koi, white and red colour), except Tancho (only red on the head) – no Ginrin, no Doitsu.
4. Bekko	one basic colour (shiro=white, hi=red, ki=yellow) with black markings – no Ginrin, no Doitsu.
5. Utsurimono	black basic colour, one colour markings (shiro=white, hi=red, ki = yellow) – no Ginrin, no Doitsu.
6. Asagi/Shusui	three colours (blue + white + red) with dark blue Matsuba pattern (Asagi) or dark blue Doitsu scales.
7. Koromo/Goshiki	Goshiki, Ai-, Sumi-, Budo-Goromo, Koromo-Sanke and Koromo-Showa – no Ginrin, no Doitsu.
8a. Kawarimono A	all single-coloured, non-metallic koi and single-coloured, non-metallic koi with additional dark Matsuba pattern – no Ginrin, no Doitsu.
8b. Kawarimono B	all multi-coloured, non-metallic koi which cannot be assigned to another variety, e.g. Ochiba Shigure, Matsukawabake, all Kage- und Kanoko – no Ginrin, no Doitsu.
9. Hikarimujimono	all single-coloured, metallic koi (Ogon) and single-coloured, metallic koi with additional dark Matsuba pattern – no Ginrin, no Doitsu.
10. Hikarimoyo-mono	all multicoloured, metallic koi which cannot be assigned to another variety, e.g. Kujaku, Hariwake, Yamatonishiki – no Ginrin, no Doitsu.
11. Hikari - Utsurimono	all metallic Utsuri and Kin-Showa – no Ginrin, no Doitsu.
12a Kingirin A	all Kohaku, Showa and Sanke with Ginrin- scales, except Tancho.
12b Kingirin B	all other koi with Ginrin- scales.
13. Tancho	all Kohaku, Showa and Sanke with Tancho pattern (only a red on the head) – no Ginrin, no Doitsu. All other Tancho are judged in their variety (e.g. Tancho-Goshiki in Goshiki/Koromo).
14a Doitsu A	all Kohaku, Showa and Sanke with Doitsu-scales, except Tancho.
14b Doitsu B	all other Doitsu, e.g. Kumonryu, Beni Kumonryu, Doitsu Utsuri, Doitsu Bekko, Kikusui. Attention: Shusui are judged in the Asagi/Shusui class.
